Wear Wear &Care

Your patient's ankle-foot orthosis (AFO) has been custom-designed and handcrafted to meet their unique ankle and foot needs. By advising them to follow these guidelines, you can help extend the life of their AFO and ensure it continues to provide effective therapy.

Initial Wear

- Adjustment Period: Inform patients that it may take a short period before
 the AFO feels natural. Emphasize that a proper fitting AFO should apply a
 snug fit and steady pressure against the skin.
- **Skin Inspection:** Advise patients to remove the AFO and their sock after 1-2 hours of initial wear to inspect the skin for any redness. If redness persists after 30 minutes, recommend that they contact you and continue to monitor the area.
- When to Contact a Professional: Instruct patients to contact you immediately if they experience any of the following:
 - Sharp or stabbing pain
 - Unusual swelling
 - New bruises, calluses, or blisters

Cleaning and Care

- **Daily Skin Care:** Recommend that patients wash the skin covered by the orthosis, including the bottom of the foot and between the toes, daily with mild soap and warm water. They should rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- Cleaning the AFO: Patients should hand wash their AFO with mild soap and water using a clean cloth. After applying the soap and water solution, they should rinse the cloth thoroughly and wipe the AFO surfaces clean of any soap residue. Air drying is essential—no heat should be used.
- **Maintenance:** Advise patients to have any worn, cracked, or broken portions of their orthosis assessed and repaired by you as soon as possible.

Socks

- **Proper Wear:** Patients should always wear a clean sock or stocking with their AFO to reduce friction and protect it from perspiration. Socks should extend beyond the top line of the AFO against the ankle or leg.
- Hygiene: Recommend that patients change socks daily and as needed to reduce perspiration buildup. Suggest the use of baby powder to help keep them dry and comfortable.

Shoes

- **Selection:** Encourage patients to use a proper fitting lace-up shoe for the best results. Shoes with removable insoles and/or added depth may be necessary to accommodate the AFO.
- Consistency: Advise patients to maintain a consistent heel height when switching between shoes.
- Monitoring Wear: Instruct patients to notify you if they notice any irregular wear patterns on the soles of their shoes.

By following these guidelines and advising your patients accordingly, you can ensure the optimal performance and longevity of their custom AFOs, supporting their mobility and comfort effectively.
