What you need to fit a Paww

Below is a list of everything you'll need to fit an Paww. Make sure you have all items ready before you begin, and follow the instructions step by step to guide you through the fitting process.





Paww + Dock

Available in 3 sizes: This is the core structure of the Paww, with the dock securely attached at the palm



Available in 3 sizes: The cover adds style and an extra layer of protection

Fitting Equipment

Measurements required for fitting the Paww







Measure circumference of the **palm**



Measure the length from wrist to the end of the limb

Paww Sizing Chart

Use **measurement X, Y & Z** to select the appropriate size

Measurement X	Measurement Y	Measurement Z	Paww size
7cm - 13cm	7cm - 14cm	3cm +	Small
12cm - 18cm	13cm - 20cm	5cm +	Medium
16cm - 22cm	17cm - 25cm	8cm +	Large



Scan for our online sizing calculator

Enter the user's limb measurements, and the calculator will determine the correct size Paww

Fitting the Paww blank



Choose one of the three Paww sizes that best fits the user




Undo the Velcro straps and gently slide the user's palm into the Paww



Secure the Velcro straps around the palm and wrist, ensuring they're snug but comfortable

Fitting the Paww cover



Choose the matchingsize cover for the Paww



Place the cover on the back of the user's hand and secure it with the Velcro tabs



The top flap can be folded over for extra coverage if the user has a partial hand



When you turn the user's hand over, ensure the dock is centred in the middle of the palm or limb



For partial fingers, either fold the top of the cover inside



Or trim along the top to remove it



This will allow the digits to remain free for movement

Fitting the Paww tools



Attach the tool to the dock by pressing it in firmly



The tool will stay in a fixed position



Keeping it secure on your palm for any activity



To release the tool, press the button underneath the dock



You can then rotate the tool and push it back into the dock to lock it



It can be set at any angle, a full 360°, anywhere around the dock

Fitting the Paww tools



Easily swap out any of our tools and insert them into the Paww



Each is designed for a different activity



How to care for the Paww

To keep the Paww in great condition and working at its best, a little care goes a long way. Below are some top tips to help keep it clean, comfortable.



Ensure the Paww is **comfortable** and not too tight on the user's arm. If the Paww leaves marks on the user's skin that don't fade within 20 minutes, it's too tight and should be loosened.



Make sure the Paww is positioned correctly, with the tool release button resting under the user's palm or limb.



Make sure all digits are clear of the dock when attaching tools to the Paww.



Regularly **clean** the Paww and tools by wiping away any excess dirt with a damp cloth to maintain hygiene and functionality.



To **wash** the Paww, remove the tool then place it in your regular wash at 30°C (86°F).



To extend the life of the Paww and tools, store them in a cool, dry place when not in use.
