Putting on your Paww



Undo the velcro straps and slide your palm into the Paww



Do up the velcro straps so they're secure around your palm and wrist



When you turn your hand over, the dock should sit in the centre of your palm or limb



Add the cover to the back of your hand and use the velcro tabs to secure it on



The top flap can be folded over for extra coverage if you have a partial-hand



For partial fingers, to keep fingers free, you can either fold the top of the cover back or trim it off

Adding your Paww tools



Attach the tool to the dock by pressing it in firmly



The tool will stay in a fixed position



Keeping it secure on your palm for any activity



To release the tool, press the button underneath the dock



You can then rotate the tool and push it back into the dock to lock it



It can be set at any angle, a full 360°, anywhere around the dock






















How to care for your Paww

To keep your Paww in great condition and working at its best, a little care goes a long way. Below are some top tips to help you keep it clean, comfortable, and ready for whatever you've got planned.



Ensure the Paww is **comfortable** and not too tight on your arm. If the Paww leaves marks on your skin that don't fade within 20 minutes, it's too tight and should be loosened.



Make sure the Paww is positioned correctly, with the tool release button resting under your **palm or limb.**



Make sure all digits are $\mbox{{\bf clear}}$ of the dock when attaching tools to the Paww.



Regularly **clean** your Paww and tools by wiping away any excess dirt with a damp cloth.



To **wash** your Paww, remove the tool then place it in your regular wash at **30°C (86°F)**.



To extend the life of the Paww and tools, store them in a **cool, dry place** when not in use.
